### 3 High Line Hotel

Blink and you might mistake Chelsea's latest debut for an old-world university campus. Housed in a wing of the General Theological Seminary, which stands on a former apple orchard, the 1895 Gothic-style structure has stained-glass windows and cloistered courtyards that give it a stately, collegiate feel.

But modernity isn't far away—hipster favorite Intelligentsia Coffee Bar opened its first East Coast shop in the mosaic-tiled lobby; cult bakery Mah Ze Dahr serves caramel-oatmeal bars from the hotel's 1963 Citroën van parked by the entrance; and it's just a short walk east to the High Line park.
